NOTICE OF RACE

1. **Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
2. **Eligibility:** The entrant and the person-in-charge of all boats shall be a member of a club affiliated with Sail Canada, or if not a resident in Canada, a member of an organization affiliated with another ISAF member national authority, or a member of that authority. Proof of membership may be required. Boats entering handicap classes must have a valid PHRF NS rating. Boats entering One Design classes must comply with the provisions of their Class measurement rules.
3. **Classes:** The regatta is open to the following classes: Spinnaker and White Sail handicap sailing under PHRF NS ratings on a time-on-time basis. Fleet splits will be determined by the number of registrants and range of ratings of the registered boats at the sole discretion of the OA. Ratings will be as published in the PHRF NS Yacht List as at 22 July, 2017. Where no ratings are on file with PHRF NS, a rating will be assigned by the OA at its sole discretion.

One-Design starts will be offered where a minimum of 5 boats per class are registered.

Levels starts will be offered where mutual interest is expressed from a minimum of 5 boats within a rating band of 15 sec/mile.



4. **Entry Fee:** \$65.00 per Boat, includes morning coffee, doughnuts and muffins.
5. **Schedule:** The regatta will be held on Saturday July 22nd, and Sunday July 23rd, 2017.

6. **Courses:** All classes will sail fixed-mark courses according to the 2017 BBYC Course Card.
7. **Scoring:** One race is required for a series. A maximum of 5 races will be sailed. When fewer than 5 races are sailed a boat's score will be the total of her race scores. When 5 races are sailed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
8. **Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers in each class. Other prizes may be awarded at the OA's discretion.



9. **Insurance:** All boats shall carry and have available for inspection proof of \$1,000,000.00 liability insurance.
